ITINERARY

This trip is limited to 30 people due to available lodging at the Grand Canyon

- Tues. Oct 26 Today we fly to Phoenix . We drive to Sedona, considered one of the most beautiful places in the US. We encounter red-rock monoliths with names like Cathedral, Bell and Coffee pot because their massive outlines resemble these distinctive shapes. We stop for pictures. We spend tonight in Sedona. D
- Wed. Oct. 27 After breakfast we take a trolley tour around Sedona and see the sights and highlights. After lunch we travel through beautiful Oak Creek Canyon to the South Rim of the Grand Canyon. You can catch the sunset at Hopi Point using the free shuttle bus. We spend tonight on the South Rim of the Grand Canyon at Kachina Lodge. B
- Thur. Oct. 28 Your morning is free to enjoy the many sights along the canyon rim. See the sun rise at Yak Point using the free shuttle bus. Visit the Bright Angel History Room, KOLB Brothers Photo Studio and Hopi House. After lunch we will make stops along the canyon rim as we exit the park to the east and travel to Monument Valley. We spend tonight in Kayenta. B
- Fri. Oct. 29 Breakfast is included at the hotel. We visit Monument Valley with a Navajo guide on a 2 1/2 hour tour to view many of the famous monuments. We travel to Moab, Utah for a two night stay. Jet boat ride on the Colorado River is possible depending on water level. B, D

- Sat. Oct. 30 Breakfast is included at the hotel. Today we visit Arches National Park, one of the geographic wonders of the world. This afternoon we visit Dead Horse State Park. B
- Sun. Oct. 31 Breakfast is included at the hotel. We leave Moab today and travel across the state of Utah to Bryce Canyon National Park. We see the “Hoodoos” and their fantastic red, orange and pink limestone spirals. The natural amphitheater and canyons glow with different lights throughout the day. We spend tonight in Bryce City. B
- Mon. Nov. 1 Breakfast is included at our hotel. Around noon we leave Bryce City and travel to Zion National Park. We descend into half-mile deep Zion National Park, named by Mormon pioneers who were spiritually moved by the fabulous rock formations. Colorful sandstone walls rise thousands of feet above the lush greenery of the canyon floor. On our way to the canyon floor we pass through Zion Tunnel. We spend tonight in Springdale, Utah. B
- Tues. Nov. 2 Breakfast is included at our hotel. Shuttle buses leave from the visitor’s center and take you to all the highlights in Zion NP. After lunch we leave Zion National Park and travel to Lake Powell. We see Lake Powell this afternoon on the Antelope Canyon Boat Tour. We spend tonight in Page, Arizona. B, D
- Wed. Nov. 3 Breakfast is included at our hotel. Today we travel to Phoenix with a late afternoon flight. B
