Arrive in Charleston

Thur. Mar. 24 Today we fly to Charleston, S.C. We spend tonight near the airport.

Charleston

Fri. Mar. 25 A free day to explore and discover Charleston. Our hotel for the next two nights is the Meeting Street Inn located at the corner of Meeting Street and Market Street. This is the center of shopping and dining in Charleston. We enjoy wine, cheese and hot snacks on the Meeting Street Inn patio this evening. **B**

Charleston

Sat. Mar. 26 Today we explore Charleston. This 300-year old city is renowned for its splendid architecture. Charleston is one of the last bastions of southern gentility. We begin with a comprehensive city tour of historic Charleston. After lunch we enjoy a narrated harbor cruise including Fort Sumter where the first battle of the Civil War was fought. As time permits you may want to visit Calhoun Mansion- one of the most elaborate show places in the Old South or Nathaniel Russell house-a fine example of Federal architecture. Again this evening we enjoy wine, cheese and hot snacks on the Meeting Street Inn patio. **B**

Magnolia Plantation/ Beaufort/ Savannah

Sun. Mar. 27 We start our day at Magnolia Plantation on the Ashley River. Owned the Drayton family for over three centuries. Magnolia Plantation offers the oldest major public gardens in America. We enjoy a house tour, the beautiful gardens and much more. Lunch at Magnolia Plantation. We travel to Beaufort and enjoy a narrated carriage ride through this historic city. Our hotel in Savannah is in the heart of the historic district where shopping and restaurants abound. We spend two nights in Savannah. **B, L**

Sightsee Savannah

Mon. Mar. 28

We have the entire day to enjoy Savannah's historic district. Old Trolley Tours picks up near the hotel and provides a narrated tour of America's first planned city. The trolley makes 12 stops where you can get off and tour Savannah's premier historic houses or city market or River Street. Trolley's run every 30 minutes so simply reboard and continue the tour until you want to get off again. **B**

St. Simon Island/ Jekyll Island

Tues. Mar. 29

We depart Savannah and travel south to the Golden Isles of Georgia. This term refers to St. Simon Island, Jekyll Island and Sea Island. We visit Jekyll Island whose history began in 1888 when Rockefeller, Morgan, Gould, Goodyear and Pulitzer purchased the island. They used the island as a hunting preserve and family getaway. The Jekyll Island Club Hotel where we stay 2 nights, is listed in Historic Hotels of America. The hotel began a century ago when it was founded as an exclusive retreat for members of America's highest society.

We enjoy a tour of the hotel and admire its beauty and many public areas.
